

PCM 2 Advanced Motivation and Engagement Skills

PCM 2 Advanced Motivation and Engagement Skills is a 3-day seminar that enables participants to learn more about human behaviour, relational dynamics and further develop the Process Communication Model® skills. It takes the skills learnt during the Engaging and Motivating Students seminar to the next level. This advanced level seminar is focussed on understanding how the 'more' problematic teacher-student relationships can be managed, what the underlying causes are likely to be, how to find the best solutions and how to manage conflict constructively.

This highly interactive seminar provides participants with the opportunity to put into practice motivational techniques and learn how to feed psychological needs in a positive way to maximise student engagement, wellbeing, self-efficacy and learning outcomes. Participants learn the types and stages of distress that lead to conflict, they discover new insights into their own personality and learn how to apply the skills developed to assess the personality structure of students and others, resolve conflicts and address negative and non-productive behaviours.

Intended Audience:

Teachers and educators wishing to develop their communication skills and build their ability to engage and motivate students and develop more productive relationships with parents and other colleagues. This course is particularly suited to Principals, Deputy Principals and Head Teachers who work with students who have been identified as vulnerable, disengaged or difficult students.

Learning Outcomes:

Participants develop an advanced level of understanding of how to identify and manage the underlying issues associated with disengaged and non-productive student behaviours. At the end of the seminar teachers and educators will be able to identify and address the causes of distress and non-productive behaviour. Participants will become more skilled at motivating and supporting students to build their self-efficacy, goal setting and focus.
