



Engaging and Motivating Students (PCM 1: Core Concepts for Educators)

Engaging and Motivating Students is a 3-day highly interactive personal and professional development seminar based on Dr. Taibi Kahler's Process Communication Model® (PCM) seminar for educators (PCM1). The seminar is specifically developed for use in education and provides participants with 19 hours of NESAC certified professional development at the Proficient Teacher level.

During the seminar participants get an in-depth understanding of self, others and how to tailor communication, manage stress and distress. Participants get to learn about psychological needs, deep motivation and practice intervention and conflict management strategies. Participants are shown how to assess communication preferences and psychological needs in others and how they can easily 'shift their energy' to connect, motivate and engage more effectively with students, colleagues, parents and family.

Intended Audience:

Teachers and educators wishing to develop their communication skills and build their ability to engage and motivate students and develop more productive relationships with parents and other colleagues. This course is particularly useful for teachers and educators whose task it is to regularly manage interventions with vulnerable, disengaged or difficult students.

Learning Outcomes:

Participants learn about the PCM framework for understanding personality structure and the causes of both positive and negative behaviours. At the end of the seminar teachers and educators will understand the diversity of personalities, strengths, distress behaviours and how they can build student efficacy and maintain an 'OK' mindset in the classroom. Teachers and educators will be able to determine the psychological needs of students, tailor and adapt the way they engage, communicate and motivate others.
